# REQUIREMENTS, RULES, and POLICIES

: Baja Bible School is a community of Christians seeking to grow in conformity to the character of Jesus Christ. :  
: We value and strive to maintain the high moral standards of Scripture. Our philosophy regarding discipline is :  
: that we prefer to have only a few rules in favor of asking our students to join us in creating a community of :  
: Christian love for one another, sacrifice for one another, encouragement to one another, forgiveness of one an- :  
: other and edification of one another. The rules that we do have are designed to protect our community, promote :  
: good relationships, promote learning, and show sensitivity to the culture in which we live. :

Upon arrival to campus, you will be asked to sign a community living covenant that includes the following guidelines:

## A. General

1. While a high school diploma is not required, the minimum age for attendance is 18.
2. Medical coverage for students attending is strongly advised. Baja has no medical treatment facilities and does not supply student medical insurance. Students will be required to sign a medical waiver form if they do not have medical insurance.
3. The use of illegal drugs is not allowed on or off campus. Those using these substances should not apply for admission. In order to show sensitivity to the culturally conservative Christian church in Mexico, students are also required to abstain from alcohol and tobacco use on and off campus while they are at Baja Bible School.

## B. Community Living

4. Learning in community is an important part of our program, therefore, students are required to live on campus. Occasionally exceptions are made. Please contact our office if you think your situation might constitute an exception.
5. Students participate in cleaning and taking care of our facility. There will be scheduled work times, community activities, worship times, and service opportunities on weekdays. Weekends are free time for travel off campus or relaxation on campus. ## C. Vehicles

6. Due to limited parking and the liability involved in having a car in Mexico, students are not allowed to bring vehicles to Baja Bible. Tijuana has an adequate public transportation system which students are encouraged to use for daily activities. Baja Bible will provide transportation for airport pick-ups and drop-offs during registration days and holiday departures.

## D. Classroom

7. On-time class attendance is expected. All classes are held in English, except for Spanish classes. Spanish study before attending Baja is encouraged but is not required.

## E. Dormitory

8. Women are not allowed in men's dorms, and men are not allowed in women's dorms.
9. Curfew is enforced. Students are required to be in their rooms by 12:00 a.m.
10. Televisions and weapons are not allowed. Desktop computers are discouraged because of space. Students should bring mainly necessities and be careful about how much they pack. The dorm rooms have limited space.

## F. Culture

11. Dress on and off campus should be in good taste. Modesty and consideration of others is the general rule. On campus, students should consider the edification of others. Off campus students should try to dress in a way that does not call attention to themselves.
12. Local pastors provide training in cultural issues. Bring an attitude ready to learn from your Mexican neighbors and willing to serve those around you.

## G. Passports

13. Passports are required. Students must bring a valid passport with them.
